ABOUT CO-MEMO-S

The Co-Memo-S project aims to design a comprehensive training program for youth workers that empowers them to connect younger and older generations around the theme of sustainability by exploring and sharing local socio-ecological memories and knowledge.

The parts of this comprehensive training program are the following:

1. **a Handbook:** state of the arts, ideas, stories, and tools that the youth workers can use in their own way,
2. **educational videos:** about air pollution, water pollution, climate change, ecosystem exploitation and greenhouse gases emission,
3. **an E-learning platform and a Virtual Archive:** with socio-ecological memories.
