This elaborated comprehensive training program is available in English, Bulgarian, Greek, Hungarian, Spanish and Romanian and it includes:

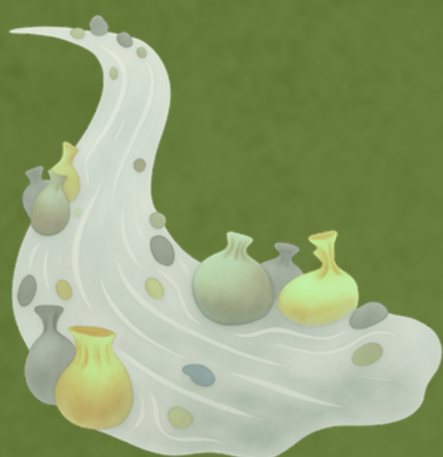
A Handbook: Whether you are planning a workshop, starting a local project, or simply opening a conversation between generations, this handbook is here to walk beside you!
